GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The tournament goals are to promote Wushu, attracting children, the youth and adults to practicing Wushu. Raising the spirit of the warrior among practitioners, improvement of Wushu skills, exchange experience between the athletes of the various countries, to select athletes into teams and to promote healthy way of life.

Attracting Wushu teams from all over the world to the competition organized by the Estonian Sports and Traditional Wushu Federation.

2. Organizers: Sportsclub Julged and Estonian Sports and Traditional Wushu Federation.

3. Competition is based on: Taolu and Tuishou.

4. Location- competition venue:

5. **Preliminary entry form:** might be sent after receiving the regulations, but not later than 20 of July 2019. (www.competitionbook.com priit@kungfu.ee).

20 of August 2019 is the deadline to register to the competitors who need a VISA to participate in the championships in Estonia. The list of competitors should be verified by the National Olympic Committee of the participating country.

6. **Final entry form:** must be sent not later than 20 of August 2019. (www.competitionbook.com priit@kungfu.ee).

You need to register a member that will add the information for the team. You will be sent the user name and password (priit@kungfu.ee).

REGISTRATION FEE

Registration fee Taolu, 15 EUR and Tuishou 15 EUR each event.

JUDGES

Each Team brings their own judges, depending of the participation events (Taolu). If team has less than 3 athletes, no judge needed!

If a team does not send judges, they will have a penalty of 100€ for missing judge per event.

COMPOSITION OF TEAM

Pay attention the total number of athletes is not limited.

Please find the registration on the website: www.competitionbook.com

and mark all the team members statuses there (team leader; coach, doctor, judge, athlete, president of federation, guest).

PARTICIPATION

1. Any team approved by national federations - members of EWuF and IWuF are allowed to participate.

2. All applications shall bear the stamp and signature of the respective team manager.

3. There are no limitations for the number of national teams and team size.

4. DOCUMENTS

All competitors are required to hand in:

- National passport (original);
- Health certificates (including ECG). The Health Certificate is only valid if it has been issued within a period of 30 days prior to the competition;
- Valid Health Insurance Certificate;
- For Tuishou athletes – health certificate showing electroencephalogram (EEG),
- Electrocardiogram (ECG), blood pressure and heart rate in a medical check-up taken within 30 days before registration should be submitted at the time of team registration;
- All names and surnames must be typed in English.

8.1 AGE GROUPS

Taolu:

- Children age 8 years and younger;
- Children: 9 – 10 years (included);
- Children: 11 – 12 years (included);
- Cadets: 13 – 14 years (included);
- Juniors: 15 – 17 years (included);
- Adults: 18 – 35 years (included);
- Adults: 36-60 years (included);
- Adults: 61+ years ;

Full age is determined by the athlete age on **20 September 2019**.

8.2. TAOLU COMPETITION PROGRAM

Forms are divided into 4 groups: A, B, C, D:

- A group is for **Optional** forms; Adults: 15 – 17 years (included) and 18 – 35 years (included);
- B group is for **standard** (3 set) forms; Juniors: 15 – 17 years (included) and Adults: 18 – 35 years (included);
- C group is for **standard** forms (1, 2, set); Cadets: 13 – 14 years (included);
- D group is for **32 forms**; Children: 11 – 12 years (included);
- E group is for **basic forms** (16, 20 forms, 32 forms two lines, etc.); Children age 12 years and younger
This applies to all weapon and barehand forms.

1. Barehanded forms: Changquan, Nanquan, Taijiquan;

2. Short weapons: Jianshu, Daoshu, Nandao;

3. Long weapons: Qiangshu, Gunshu, Nangun;

4. Taiji jian.

NOTE! Competition includes individual competition only.

Unless otherwise states within these regulations, the competition will be conducted in accordance with the “EWUF TAOLU Competition Rules” (www.ewuf.org).

Group 1: Traditional Taijiquan

Traditional Taijiquan including Chen, Yan, Sun, Wu, Wu (Hao), Li, Zhaobao and other Taijiquan styles divided in Taijiquan competition.

Group 2: Traditional Bagua, Xingyi, Bajiquan.

Traditional Bagua, Xingyi, Bajiquan styles divided into quanshu competition.

Group 3: Traditional Nanquan

Traditional Guandong, Fujian, Sichuan, etc. Nanquan schools (Hong, Li, Mo, Cailifo) divided into quanshu competition.

Group 4: Traditional Shaolinquan

Traditional Songshan shaolinquan divided into quanshu, qixie (weapons) competition.

Group 5: Imitation styles

All imitation routines including Houquan, Yinzhuaquan, Zuiquan, Tanglangquan, Ditangquan, Zonghequan, Minghequan, Heihuquan, etc. divided into quanshu competition.

Group 6: Traditional Tongbei, Fanzi, Chuojiao, Pigua styles.

Traditional Tongbei, Fanzi, Chuoqiao, Pigua styles divided into quanshu competition.

Group 7: Traditional Yongchun (Wing chun)

Traditional Yongchun quanshu routines biaozi and xunqiao (chum kyu and biu jee); Forms from Chinese Duanwei system; Wing Chun Duilian (self composed and standard Wing Chun set-sparring from Chinese Duanwei system.

No time limit for Yongchun (Wing Chun) forms.

Group 8: Traditional Wudang styles.

Zhang Sanfeng Taijiquan, Songxi Neijiaquan, Baxianquan, Xuanwuquan, Wudang Baguaquan, Wudang Xingyiquan, Taiwuxingquan, etc.

Group 9: Other traditional styles.

All other traditional quanshu and weapons routines: Chaquan, Huaquan, Baoquan, Baimei (Pakmei), Liuhequan, Gongliquan, Yuejiaquan, etc.

Traditional weapons:

Group 1: single short weapons

Group 2: single long weapons

Group 3: double weapons

Group 4: flexible weapons

Time of performance: not less than 1 min.

Group 5: Taiji weapons (Taiji qixie).

8.4. DUILIAN fighting sets

8.4.1 Barehand vs. barehand

8.4.2. Weapon vs. weapon

Time of performance:

- For A and B groups – not less than 1 min 20 sec
- For Taijiquan and Taiji weapons from 3 min to 4 min
- Other groups 40sec to 2 min.

NOTE! Competition includes individual competition only.

The Rules are IWUF and EWUF competition Rules for standard and traditional events.

For Wing Chun the basic criteria of Chinese Duanwei system shall be applied as Rules.

There'll be only individual competition, that takes place under the Rules for EWUF Wushu Taolu Competition.

The age calculation is based on October 19 2018

9. Tuishou

Aim of the competition:

1. Determining of champions and winners of Wushu Tuishou (Pushing hands) in each weight category by conducting personal championships in Fixed Step, Moving Step, Free Moving Step nominations.
2. In each weight category will be champion, silver and bronze medalists.
3. Determining of absolute champion among the champions of the weight categories in Fixed Step nominations.
4. The organizing committee of the tournament reserves the right to change the rules of competition and weight categories in case there are not enough applications received by the deadline.

Cadets from 7 to 15 years

Juniors from 16 to 18

Adults of 19 years also are more senior

Male: 25kg, 30kg, 35kg, 40kg, 45kg, 50kg, 55kg, 60kg, 65kg, 70kg, 75kg, 80kg, 85kg, 90kg, 95kg+

Female: 25kg, 30kg, 35kg, 40kg, 45kg, 50kg, 55kg, 60kg, 65kg, 70kg, 75kg, 80kg, 85kg, 90kg, 95kg+

If there are too few participants registered for a weight class it may be cancelled or combined with another weight class. A new weight class can be created if necessary.

Children's Event

Participants younger than 14 years are in a separate group and can participate in the competition only with the consent of the teacher and the parent's written permission.

Competitions:

Competitions are held in a circular system. In case of a large number of participants competition will be held in a Olympic system - on shootout.

Awards:

Champions and prize-winners in each weight category will be awarded medals (gold, silver and bronze) and honorary diplomas.

Payment

Participation price for Tuishou – 15 euro. For each additional category – 15 euro

10. The Panel of Appeal: P. Kõrve, R.Vlasenko, V. Palmet, G. Kisseljov. The appeal can be submitted not later than 30 min after the end of the appropriate event. The appeal fee 100 €, will be spent for the tournament needs. The draw-lots are computer-based. Will be performed after submitting the final entry forms. All teams will receive the detailed list of events on the day of arrival.

INSURANCE AND MEDICAL DOCUMENTS

All athletes shall provide valid insurance and medical documents as listed in the EWUF Wushu Competition regulations.

11. AWARDING

The awarding will be carried out following the EWUF Rules, unless stated otherwise. In EWUF Taolu competition, in case there are more than 3 competitors, 3 medals are awarded. In case there are 3 competitors 1st and 2nd places are awarded. In case there are 2 competitors, only 1st place is awarded.

If there will be only 1 or 2 persons registered for any event, this event will be joined to another event without the special agreement with the team's officials.

12. PAYMENT

The participation fee must be paid at time of final application form submitting. All the fees must be paid by bank transfer to Organizing Committee bank account.

The balance for the accommodation and any other fees can be paid in EUR at time of team registration. All payments must be made in full before participation in the event.
